PUBLIC HEARING: To Discuss a Project Summary and Preliminary Environmental Impacts Relative to the Redirection of the East Sewer Area of the Village of Lakewood, Currently Served by the City of Crystal Lake, to the Lakewood Utilities Wastewater Treatment Plant and Planning for Such Project: The proposed project consists of the installation of approximately 6,850 linear feet of 8-inch force main, a pumping station, and 2,600 feet of 8-inch gravity sewer to feed wastewater from the East Sewer Area into the Turnberry Interceptor.
