

**VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD
MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 - 2024
APRIL 11, 2023**

The Village Public Hearing for the Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 was held in-person at Crosspoint Lutheran Church, 8505 Redtail Drive, along with Zoom viewing. It was called to order at 6:36 p.m. by President Stavropoulos. Present at Crosspoint Lutheran Church were Trustees Augustine, Babischkin, Barron, Berman, Fischer, and Runge. Also present were Village Manager Jean Heckman, Village Attorney Scott Puma, Village Clerk Jeanette LoBosco, Director of Public Works Gary Zickuhr, Chief of Police Mike Roth, RedTail Golf Club General Manager Kenny Goodwin, and a few members of the public.

CONFIRMATION OF PUBLICATION OF PROPER NOTICE: Village Clerk LoBosco confirmed proper notice of the hearing was made. She stated the notice was published in the Northwest Herald March 24, 2023, along with posting to the Village Website and Facebook page.

PRESENTATION OF PROPOSED ANNUAL BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023 – 2024: Village Manager Heckman noted the changes made to the proposed budget since the Budget Workshop held March 14, 2023.

Reflected in the proposed budget are the adjustments needed for the addition of a tenth police officer; salary, IMRF contribution, taxes and insurance. Also requiring an adjustment to Professional Development for a new police recruit to attend the training academy.

It was noted approval of the tenth officer is on the agenda for the Village Board Meeting that is scheduled to follow the evening's hearing.

VILLAGE BOARD COMMENTS: No comments were made.

With nothing further to discuss, Trustee Runge, seconded by Trustee Augustine moved to adjourn the Public Hearing.
