

**VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024 - 2025
APRIL 23, 2024**

The Village Public Hearing for the proposed budget for Fiscal Year 2024 - 2025 was held in-person at Crosspoint Lutheran Church, 8505 Redtail Drive, along with Zoom viewing.
