

**VILLAGE OF LAKEWOOD
MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL VILLAGE BOARD MEETING
JANUARY 18, 2022**

The Village Board Meeting was held in-person at RedTail Golf Club, 7900 RedTail Drive along with Zoom viewing. It was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by President Stavropoulos. Present at RedTail Golf Club were Trustees Babischkin, Barron, Fischer, and Runge. Absent were Trustees Augustine and Berman. Also present were Village Manager Jean Heckman, Village Clerk Jeanette LoBosco, Chief of Police Mike Roth, RedTail Golf Club Manager Kenny Goodwin, Administrative Services Manager Sue Villie, and many members of the public.

OATH OF OFFICE OF POLICE OFFICER: Village Clerk LoBosco administered the Oath of Office to Michael Jedlicka as Police Officer.


OATH OF OFFICE OF POLICE OFFICER: Village Clerk LoBosco administered the Oath of Office to Jacob Bardi as Police Officer.
